Shop front improvements

Jan Kattein and his team are delivering the shop front improvement scheme and the programme is to get works started on site in September 2013.

The shop front proposals have now been submitted for planning and advertising consent. Detail of the proposals will be available via Southwark Council's planning applications register www.southwark.gov.uk

The first four shops have had their festoon lighting installed and with 22 shops signed up we look set to transform the evening appearance of the high street. The remaining shops will have the lights included in the main shop front works contract.

To ensure that Nunhead as a whole and most shops benefit we are prioritising works based on a shop front condition survey and what is practically needed. Shop owners are also being invited to extend their works through financial contributions.

Nunhead's pop up shop: Nunhead Corner



Nunhead Corner is open every Tuesday from 10am until 6pm until 18 June for you to find out about all the projects going on within the regeneration programme. It has been a great opportunity to meet and talk with lots of locals about the projects and how much people really enjoy living in Nunhead. We will maintain a display during the pop up tenancies so that you can still be kept informed about what is happening with the various regeneration projects.

It is also really exciting that Nunhead Corner will be transforming into a pop up shop with five, seven week long tenancies running over the next year. We will be signing contracts with tenants shortly

but we have some great new shops to add to the vibrancy of the high street. The first tenant is Charlie Foxtrot Vintage who had a pop up shop earlier in the year at 147 Evelina Road. This will be followed by Nunhead Gallery in September; Stylish woman, stylish mama in autumn, JH Beulah Eco Couture in December and Lana furniture in February.

Lighting

The bridge lighting installation is on site and will be completed by early July providing you with a brighter, lighter walking route in the evening.

Nunhead mosaics

We are thrilled that an application to the Council's Cleaner Greener Safer fund for Nunhead mosaics was successful and I am working with the applicant to deliver another great project in Nunhead.



Garden walls on Evelina Road

Phase 2 of the environmental improvements replacing the front garden walls on Evelina Road will take place this summer. There are 15 properties involved which will bring about a great outcome for the street.

Road resurfacing

Design of the drop kerbs on the northern footway of Evelina Road is being undertaken and I will confirm when the works are programmed.

Electric vehicle point

The new point on Cheam St outside Nunhead Corner is a part of the Source London network which costs a £10 membership per year and entitles member to use all Source points in London and the Source East (East of England). Full details and real time information is available on www.sourcelondon.net.
